

COVID-19 School Operations Plan Survey Results

Survey Analysis

A survey was conducted via Google Forms between September 14-16, 2021 regarding the development of the district’s COVID-19 school operations plan. Below is a summary of the responses from 46 staff members, 65 students (6th through 12th grades), 123 parents, and 21 taxpayers.

Which of the following best represents your views in regard to wearing face masks in school?

Face masks should never be required	20%	2%	22%	19%
Face masks should only be required of unvaccinated persons	11%	7%	< 1%	5%
Face masks should only be required when COVID-19 cases are high in the community	38%	37%	33%	24%
Face masks should be required for the remainder of the school year	20%	39%	31%	38%

A “Test to Stay” program allows nonsymptomatic students who have been exposed to a positive COVID-19 case to continue attending school by receiving a negative COVID-19 test result each morning for a set number of days.

Would you support CISD scheduling a date every two weeks for free, voluntary COVID-19 testing at school? This would be available to students, staff, and student households.

School districts in Kentucky have the option this year of completing 1,062 hours of instruction rather than 170 days. For CISD, this would be 166 days rather than the current schedule of 174. Which school calendar option do you prefer the most?

Move the end date to May 10th and use NTI/remote learning when necessary (166 total days)	40%	46%	51%	57%
