CISD Families,

At their special called meeting yesterday evening, the Cloverport Board of Education approved the proposal outlined in my October 30, 2020 [letter](#) to you regarding providing additional preparation time to our teachers. I am grateful to our board for their consideration and courage in taking this step. Our teachers desperately need this, and the benefits to students in the long run will be tremendous.

On the following Wednesdays, only CISD staff will report to the school building, while students remain home: November 11th and 18th; December 2nd, 9th, and 16th; January 6th, 13th, and 27th; February 3rd, 10th, and 24th; March 3rd, 10th, 17th, and 24th; April 14th, 21st, and 28th; and May 5th and 12th. If you are without childcare on these days due to work, please complete this [survey](#) by 3:30 p.m. on Monday, November 9th so that we can make preparations for your child here at school. Please note that **preschool** students currently attending on Wednesdays and Thursdays will shift to Thursdays and Fridays.

As previously indicated, our goal is to make this at home learning experience as easy as possible on parents, while still providing an academic benefit to students. Below is an overview of what your child will be expected to do on these days. When necessary, accommodations will be made for students without internet access.

- **Kindergarten through 2nd grade** students will have one phonics/spelling, reading, and math activity to complete each day. All work will be paper based.
- **3rd through 5th grade** students will complete *Moby Max*, *Reading Plus*, and/or *Prodigy* activities online, as well as other assignments from their teacher. Students will bring their Chromebooks home each Tuesday beforehand.
- **Middle school** students will work on a “Genius Hour” project, which will consist of creating a proposal, researching a topic, and then creating a final product to show their expertise on a topic of interest.
- **High school** students will work on a long-term Literature project from November 11th to February 5th and a long-term Math/Science project from February 10th to May 12th.

Additionally, students will be provided a breakfast and lunch for each Wednesday at home. These will be sent home with them on the Tuesday beforehand.
